FALL OF A SCAFFOLDING.

One Man Killed and Several More or Less Wounded.

Chicago, Nov. 6.—By the breaking of a scaffolding raised ten feet from the ground, on which one hundred and fifty men and girls were grouped for the purpose of being photographed, at Lyon & Healy's new piano factory yesterday, one man was killed, two were probably fatally injured, and several others were badly hurt. Following is a list of the killed and injured:

Killed—William Kiechagall, fifty-six years old.

Injured—August Hasko injured about the chest and it is supposed his lungs are affected.

Dora Gofford, severe internal injuries. John Cohles, ankle broken.

E. Griffl and John Radlois, also injured.

No Special Session.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 6.—It can be stated on the authority of a Cabinet officer that the President will not call an extra session of Congress. The first of December comes on Monday, and Congress will meet in regular session on that day. There is no urgency demanding an extra session, it is stated on the same authority, and the reason that was potent in suggesting it several weeks ago, do not hold now. Only four weeks remain before the regular session begins, and members of Congress from distant States could hardly arrive here in time for a session if one were called. These and other reasons, it is said, have led the President to the determination not to call an extra session. This conclusion was reached at a last session of the Cabinet held Friday, October 31.

Took His Books and Went Home.—WASHINGTON, Nov. 6.—Mr. Kenney, the New York supervisor, who, as Mayor Grant's representative, brought to this city the stolen copies of election books, and who refused to surrender them to the Secretary, returned to New York last night with his books and documents, after reiteration, in a note to Secretary Noble, yesterday, that he could not part company with them. The next step by Mayor Grant and Mr. McKenny will be an appeal to President Harrison for a re-count in New York City.
