Shall the Board of Education of the Niangua R-V School District of Webster County, Missouri, be authorized to increase the operating tax levy ceiling through Tax Year 2035 in order to enhance the safety and security of the entire school district through construction of additional classrooms and corridors that connect all campus buildings? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating levy of the District is estimated to increase by \$0.93 from \$3.3036, currently, to \$4.2336 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the 2016 Tax Year and can be applied to the assessed valuation for each year thereafter through Tax Year 2035.

Shall the Board of Education of the Laclede County R-I School District, Laclede County, Missouri, borrow money in the amount of Two Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,700,000) for the purpose of constructing, renovating, repairing, expanding, improving, furnishing and equipping school buildings and related facilities for school purposes in the District, including, but not limited to (1) constructing classrooms, including hardening three rooms for use as a storm shelter, a principal's office, a secretary's office and a mechanical room at Ezard Elementary, and (2) improving safety, security and technology, and issue bonds for the payment thereof, resulting in an estimated increase to the debt service property tax levy of 49 cents (\$0.49) per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the District is estimated to increase from 0.000 cents (\$0.000) to 49.00 cents (\$0.4900) per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
