

Additional Cost Share Funds Available for Water Quality Improvement

10% Rebate

The James River Basin Partnership (JRBP), in collaboration with the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and Soil and Water Conservation Districts of Greene and Webster County, is offering a 10% rebate to landowners in the Upper James River sub watershed who have installed qualified best management practices as part of the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) program.

Landowners who submit a copy of their NRCS Form 1245 or a SWCD contract payment form showing that approved practices have been implemented to improve water quality will receive a 10% rebate on their portion of the cost share program.
